FINANCIAL POLICY

We are committed to provide you with the best possible dental care. Our fees reflect our professional commitment to excellence. In order to achieve these goals we need your assistance and your understanding of our payment policy. For your convenience we offer the following methods of payments.

- 1.For dental insurance patients, we will submit your dental claim on your behalf and bill you if there is a balance due. (We are not a medical office. We are a specialty dental office. We **DO NOT** submit to medical insurance.)
- 2. For our non insurance patients we expect payment in full for your initial visit.
- 3. Visa, Master Card, Discover, American Express & Care Credit are accepted.
- 4. For all of our insured/non insured patients we offer an in house payment program for future treatment plans.

We understand dental insurance and we will assist you in obtaining the maximum benefit specified in your contract. However, it is important that you realize that:

- 1. Your dental benefit program is a contract between you, your employer and the insurance company. We are not part of that contract. We will file your insurance claims as a courtesy to you.
- 2. Not all dental services are a covered benefit in all contracts.

- 3. You (not the insurance company) are responsible to us for all our fees for service rendered to you.
- 4. For patients who have insurance an **ESTIMATE** of benefits that the insurance company is expected to pay will be given to you.
